Art Gallery of Peterborough

They offer the use of these facilities for \$15/ per hour.

Artspace: Artist Run Centre

Artspace is a non-profit artist-run centre that assists artists with the presentation of new work. Artspace offers access to their Media Lab, that is equipped with an Apple computer workstation with Adobe software (Premiere, After Effects, Photoshop, Illustrator, InDesign) and an EPSON Expression 11000XL scanner, which can be used during their operating hours. The Media Lab equipment is also available at discounted rental rate.

Explore the Outdoors:

John Earle Chase Memorial – Land Trust is the 400 acre site, with over 7 km of trails, that was farmed by successive members of the Chase family until they donated the land to the Trent-Severn Waterway.

Ennismore Beach and Heritage Trail is located on the shores of Chemong Lake, is equipped with a large picnic area and a pavilion. Take a walk on the beautiful Ennismore Heritage Trail or enjoy the sun on this sandy beach. There is ample parking at this location.

Bridgenorth Trail is a 4.8 kilometer lightly trafficked out and back trail located near Smith-Ennismore-Lakefield, Ontario, Canada that offers the chance to see wildlife and is good for all skill levels. The trail offers a number of activity options and is best used from April until November.

Miller Creek Wildlife Area Loop is a 1.4 kilometer lightly trafficked loop trail located near Smith-Ennismore-Lakefield, Ontario, Canada that features beautiful wildflowers and is good for all skill levels. The trail offers several activity options and is accessible year-round.

Emily Tract is a 2.9 kilometer moderately trafficked loop trail located near Kawartha Lakes, Ontario, Canada that offers the chance to see wildlife and is good for all skill levels. The trail offers a number of activity options.

Warsaw Caves Conservation Area Trails a 5.0 kilometer moderately trafficked loop trail located near Douro-Dummer, Ontario, Canada that features a river and is rated as moderate. The trail is primarily used for hiking, walking, nature trips, and bird watching and is best used from April until October.

Harold Town MTB Trails is a 5.8 kilometer lightly trafficked loop trail located near Otonabee-South Monaghan, Ontario, Canada that features a great forest setting and is rated as moderate. The trail is primarily used for hiking, nature trips, and mountain biking and is best used from April until October.

River Road Trail is a 15.6 kilometer from Trent University to Lakefield, a lightly trafficked out and back trail that features a river and is good for all skill levels.

Lakefield Oval provides recreational skaters and speed skaters from across Ontario the opportunity to skate outdoors on a 400-metre track.

Kawartha Nordic is a Nordic ski area and club located in North Kawartha township, Peterborough County, Ontario. We offer 46 kilometres of both classic and skate trails, as well as 9 km of snowshoe trails through scenic, Canadian Shield wilderness.
